Pastoral Award 2010 cont. (Woolclassers)

replaces 'Transitional Woolclassers Award'

Award terms and conditions start from 1 January 2010. Rates listed below become effective from 1 July 2014.

1. Employment of Experts and Woolclassers will be by the day unless a longer period of engagement is agreed. Unless the Woolclasser or Expert has been notified the previous day that their attendance is not required for that day, then providing they present

2. Woolclassers and Shearing Shed Experts are FOUND Employees resides on the property for the duration of the shearing. Expeditionary employees are entitled to free board and lodging."

3. RATES OF PAY — WOOLCLASSERS

PIECEWORK RATE **\$316.58** per thousand fleeces.(All rams and/or ram stag's wool classed will be paid for at double the above rate).

4. FARES & TRAVELLING EXPENSES FOR EXPEDITIONARY EMPLOYEES

Motor Vehicle allowance **\$ 0.78** cents per kilometer.

5. TRAVEL

Woolclasser employees shall be reimbursed for all fares

An allowance at the rate of **\$ 66.23** per day

Woolclasser employees shall be paid by the employer to the employee for all expenses incurred (other than fares) while the employee is actually proceeding to and from the place of employment.

An allowance at the rate of **\$ 2.76** per hour **\$66.24** per whole day

Such allowance will be calculated at the hourly rate from the time of departure of the employee from the place of engagement or from the permanent residence until the employee arrives at the place of employment. When an employee is about to return from the place of employment such allowance will be calculated on the same basis from the time of departure until arrival at the place of engagement or permanent residence.
